

A coach's task is to make you do the things you don't want to do so you can achieve the goals you want to achieve.

- Created the OHS coaching pay scales based on level of involvement and years of experience
- Worked with varsity assistant coach, Dan Delker from 1991-1996
- Worked with freshman coaches, Dan Marks ('91), Eric Stewart ('92), Brent Schrieber ('93), and Steve Olson ('94-'96)
- Took 20 wrestlers to Antioch, CA to wrestle over winter break in 1994. The team fundraised for the trip by running the haunted hayride at Marks Farms in October. While in California, they went 4-0 in dual meets and learned some west coast freestyle wrestling. In 1995, they hosted the Antioch, CA team at OHS
- First coach to recognize varsity wrestlers on the honor roll in the wrestling programs.
 One season, all 13 starters were on the honor roll

Otto H. Daemmrich, Jr.

COACH: 1955-1962 **DECEASED:** 1962

Although Otto's life was cut tragically short, his efforts in education and athletics continue to have a positive impact in the lives of the many who followed. Oconomowoc became and still is a storied powerhouse in wrestling. Here today, Otto's two surviving children, Bob Daemmrich and Bonnie Daemmrich, and two grandsons, Chris Daemmrich and Casey Daemmrich Nelson, are proud to accept on his behalf the honor of being installed into the Oconomowoc High School Athletic Hall of Fame.


OHS COACHING:

- Began teaching physical education at OHS in 1955
- Developed a summer recreation program at OHS in 1956
- Began a wrestling club at OHS in 1956 which became the official wrestling program with Daemmrich as the first head coach in 1957
- Coached Jack Marks when he became the first individual State Champion for OHS in 1961
- Under Daemmrich's leadership, the wrestling team also placed 2nd overall at State in 1961
- During his four years leading the OHS wrestling program, he had wrestlers qualify for State

SPECIAL RECOGNITIONS:

- Wrestled for West Milwaukee High School and only lost one varsity wrestling match
- Daemmrich was not able to wrestle at the State level because there was no State Tournament during the war years (1942-45)
- Lettered in wrestling at UW-Madison his first year but an injury ended his competitive career

- After graduating from UW-Madison,
 Daemmrich began his teaching career at
 Wisconsin School for Boys in Waukesha
 where he started their wrestling program
- During his time at Wisconsin School for Boys, he also began the wrestling program at Carroll College
- Daemmrich was inducted into the Wisconsin Wrestling Hall of Fame in 1980

- Placed 3rd in the Big Ten Conference Playoffs, 1986
